**SUBJECT:** Pending Vacancy on LAFCO: Regular Public Member (Action)

> The Commission shall consider options to fill the unexpired term of vacating Commissioner Guy Kay. Commissioner Kay has provided notice of his intent to resign as regular public member effective December 14, 2006 in order to assume office with the Napa County Regional Park and Open Space

District. The position has an unexpired term that ends in May 2010.

In November, Commissioner Guy Kay provided notice of his intent to resign as regular public member effective December 14, 2006 in order to assume office with the Napa County Regional Park and Open Space District. Commissioner Kay has informed staff that he will provide formal written notice of his resignation at the December 4, 2006 meeting. position has an unexpired term that ends in May 2010. The Commission should decide how it wishes to fill this pending vacancy.

The Commission's Policies Regarding the Positions of Public Member and Alternate Public Member provides guidance to the Commission with respect to the appointment of a public member upon a mid-term vacancy. A summary of available options follows.

- The Commission can appoint one of the three remaining candidates that applied for the position in April 2006. These candidates include Brian Kelly, Dr. Vic Nienu, and Wendy Ward (application materials attached). This option remains available to the Commission through April 2007.
- The Commission can appoint the alternate public member, Brian Kelly. If this option is exercised, the Commission should direct staff to initiate a search for candidates to assume the current term of the alternative public member position that ends in April 2008 in the manner prescribed in its adopted policies.
- The Commission can direct staff to initiate a new search for candidates in the manner prescribed in its adopted policies. If this option is exercised, staff will immediately circulate an announcement to local news outlets regarding the opening and filing This would allow candidates to be presented to the period for the position. Commission at its February 5, 2007 meeting as part of a public hearing. (This date would be the earliest time the Commission could consider an appointment due to its policy requiring that the announcement of the opening and filing period for the position occur no less than 60 days prior to the hearing.)
