Hear about the status of a possible new community services district

A community services district (CSD) is a local municipal agency with authority to provide a broad range of services. A CSD is governed by an independent board of directors consisting of district residents.

Hear from LAFCO staff on LAFCO's role

LAFCOs are political subdivisions of the State of California responsible for regulating city and special district boundaries. LAFCOs are located in all 58 California counties and tasked with coordinating the logical formation and expansion of local agencies and their services while preventing urban sprawl.

LAFCO is responsible for deciding on requests for boundary changes involving local agencies as well as changes in their governance structure, such as a transition from a resort improvement district to a community services district.
