**OPPOSITION: SPHERE OF INFLUENCE AMENDMENT REQUEST INVOLVING THE CITY OF AMERICAN CANYON AND 1661 GREEN ISLAND ROAD (APN 058-030-041)**

I am writing to convey the Napa County Farm Bureau's opposition to expanding the City of American Canyon's Sphere of Influence to include 1661 Green Island Road (APN 058-030-041). This opposition is consistent with the organization's opposition in 2018, and the organizations' joint opposition along with the California Farm Bureau in 2021. This opposition is also consistent with the will of the people of American Canyon, who rejected a similar proposal by popular vote in 2022.

The fact that infill development is possible is not a compelling reason to expand the Sphere of Influence with the ultimate goal of rezoning the land from Agriculture, Watershed, and Open Space. Notwithstanding the information provided in the application, it is the Napa County Farm Bureau's opinion that the land remains viable for agricultural purposes and is currently serving as watershed and open space, consistent with current zoning.

Expanding the Sphere of Influence to include 1661 Green Island Road would set a detrimental precedent that threatens AWOS zoned land going forward, and would undermine the voters of American Canyon.
